

RULES FOR September 13, 2008 SCHOOLING SHOW

Dress Code for RIDERS:

1. Boots or riding shoes with hard soles must be worn at all times while riding.
2. Hats
 - a. Safety helmets required in all English Classes
 - b. Western classes (including Halter/Showmanship)
 - i. Under 18 must wear a helmet
 - ii. Over 18 may opt for Western hat
3. Shirts
 - a. Shirts must have collars- long sleeves are optional because it is a schooling show (regular shows require long sleeves.)
 - b. Shirt must be tucked into pants
 - c. White is suggested
4. Pants – should match the classes that are entered

Code for TACK

5. Bridles
 - a. Horses must wear a bridle with a bit that is standard to the style of riding in which they are entered. (no bosals or hackamores)
 - i. Western Class must use a curb bit
 1. Novice horse may have a snaffle in Western
 - ii. English Classes must have a snaffle or pelham
6. Saddles must be standard to the style of riding in which they are entered.
7. A horse that kicks must have a red ribbon tied to its tail to warn other riders.
8. Entry into arena may be denied for not following the rules below:
 - a. No Tie-downs or Martingales
 - b. No protective boots or wraps on horses legs
 - c. Tack that may seem dangerous to the judge or ring steward

Code for Behavior

9. Horses must not be left unattended outside the arena.
10. Unruly or rude participants may be asked to leave show without refund.
