TRVEA will help people find a place for horses and livestock during a regional fire emergency. We have volunteer ranches who have room and resources to place and care for animals until the emergency has ended. We will work with any area in the region that is evacuating.

Please note the following:

- If you need a trailer, we will try to contact volunteers who have trailers. Please tell us the type and number of animals.
- We can place stallions at some ranches.
- If you have the time, please bring feed supplies. However, we can provide some hay and feed.
- Some ranches may require that a person remain with the animals full-time. Other ranches can provide oversight of the animals without you being present. Let us know your situation.
